## Get Connected

### Wireless

Set up your computer or mobile device to connect to Brown's secure wireless network, *Brown*. Most devices can follow these steps:

1. If you are not connected to the internet or a data network, temporarily connect to the *Brown-Guest* wireless network.
2. Visit [wifi.brown.edu](http://wifi.brown.edu) and follow the steps to configure your computer or device. After the setup, make sure you are connected to the network named *Brown*.
